

JUNE 14, 2011

REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was called to order by President Mahoney at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 14, 2011 in the Township Building.

ROLL CALL

The following Commissioners were also present: Mrs. Sage, Messrs. Wechsler, Rudolph, Layden, Janiczek and Lanciano. Also present were Mr. Fulton, Mrs. Warner, as well as Kelly Sullivan, Esq., representing Township Solicitor, James Byrne, Esq.

INVOCATION

The Invocation was given by Pastor Robert Davalt of Springfield Baptist Church, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

RESOLUTION

On behalf of the Board of Commissioners, Mr. Wechsler presented a Resolution to Father Salvatore Riccio in recognition of 18 years serving as Pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Church and of his many years of inspirational service which he has given to our community.

MINUTES

On motion of Dr. Janiczek, the minutes of May 10, 2011 were approved as transcribed. Seconded by Mr. Lanciano and carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Mahoney asked if anyone in the audience wished to comment on any of the agenda items. Seeing none, the meeting continued.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Mahoney called for Committee Reports.

Ice Rink

Mrs. Sage announced the repairs on the Ice Rink roof have been completed. It will be fully operational in October when the ice skating season begins. She thanked everyone for their patience as the claim was being settled with our insurance company.

Mrs. Sage announced the Pool will be open full time starting on Saturday, June 18th.

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Dr. Janiczek reported the Code Enforcement Director would like to remind residents to evaluate their property in order to make sure their sidewalks, trees branches and shrubbery are in compliance with Township code regulations.

Code Enforcement

Mr. Rudolph read the monthly public works report. There will be no trash or recycling collection on Independence Day, Monday, July 4, 2011. He announced that the Sanitation Department stopped the weekly spring brush collection schedule and reverted back to its normal collection schedule, which is on the 3rd Wednesday of every month. Residents are asked to call the Public Works Department to schedule a pick-up. Total tons of paper collected for recycling during the month of May 2011 was 127.87 tons. Total tons of commingled collected for the same period was 72.71 tons. Total tons of trash collected during the month of May was 1,134.78 tons.

Mr. Lanciano read the Parks Department maintenance report for May. Reconstruction of the tennis courts in Memorial Park has begun. Renovations to the basketball court at Williams Park has been completed. Through a recycling grant, the Parks Department placed ten recycling containers out at various park locations.

Mr. Lanciano read the Golf Course weather and maintenance reports for May. Miscellaneous irrigation system repairs have been completed. The grounds around the pool have been prepared and all flower beds at the Clubhouse have been replanted and mulched. He also read the golf course traffic and operations report. The year-to-date revenue is down from the 7-year average.
