EROSION AND SEDIMENT POLLUTION CONTROL PLAN REVIEW FEE SCHEDULE

Waiver of Fees

Fees will be waived only for an application filed under the name of a governmental sub-unit of the United States or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including school districts and authorities. This exemption does not apply to any private, non-profit organization.

Project Area Delineation

The entire parcel controlled by the Developer will represent the project area. Open space areas are to be included in the total project area.

Applicability of Fee Schedule

The fee schedule below will apply whenever the application and Erosion and Sediment Pollution Control Plan is submitted for an adequacy determination. Each resubmission of a different project on the same tract of land will be charged an additional fee. As of Nov. 1, 1995 the fee charged will cover an initial review plus one follow-up revision submitted in response to the first review letter (if necessary). To qualify for this provision, a cover letter must be included with the resubmitted plan that outlines the extent of all revisions. Additionally, changes on the revised plan sets must be highlighted.

Plans which require more than a second review, or plans which receive a letter of adequacy and are resubmitted within two (2) years of the letter date with minor revisions will be subject to a \$100.00 processing fee only.

Plans which are resubmitted within 2 years with major revisions (such as lot layout, road layout, drainage design, etc.) shall be subject to a charge of 25% of the original fee, or \$100.00 whichever is greater.

Letters of adequacy issued by the District are valid for two years from the date of issuance. Failure to begin earthmoving within 2 years of the accepted plan will invalidate the review and require a resubmission, which is subject to an additional fee, not to exceed the review fee schedule in effect at the time of resubmittal.

Emergency Review Provision

The applicant will pay a fee twice the normal review fee. The applicant will submit two checks. Prior approval from the Conservation District Manager must be obtained to start this process. Three days will be the minimum review time for first review submittals.

The emergency review fee covers the cost of an initial review plus one follow-up revision. To qualify, as with the normal review, a cover letter detailing any revisions made and plan sets with changes highlighted are required.

The emergency review may be initiated after the conservation district's first review with the submission of a fee equal to 50% of the original review fee. This procedure is subject to all of the provisions of the normal review (cover letter, highlighted plans..). This provision will not apply to plans which are found to be incomplete or insufficient for complete review. Plans found to be either incomplete or insufficient will require a fee equal to 100% of the original review fee to initiate the emergency process.
