SPECIAL MEETING

The Special Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was called to order by President Mahoney at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 22, 2010 in the Township Building.

ROLL CALL

The following other Commissioners were present: Messrs. Janiczek, Wechsler, Rudolph, Layden, Lanciano and Mrs. Sage. Also present were Messrs. Byrne and LeFevre, as well as Mrs. Warner.

Mrs. Sage lead the Board of Commissioners with the Pledge of Allegiance.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE
2011 BUDGET

Mr. Rudolph introduced the 2011 budget which called for expenditures of \$15,668,700. He stated the General Fund Budget is balanced and includes no tax increase for 2011. The average household assessed at \$148,000 will continue to pay \$737.04 for municipal services. He noted seven full-time employees opted for the early retirement incentive program, resulting in significant savings. The sewer rent fee will remain the same. The proposed budget includes a increase of \$50 to the refuse fee.

Mr. Lanciano read the proposed budget ordinance and moved to approve it on its first reading and advertised. Seconded by Mr. Layden and carried.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE
Refuse Fee

Dr. Janiczek read a proposed ordinance amending the refuse fee to \$200 per residential dwelling unit and for persons over sixty-five years of age with an annual income of \$20,500 or less may request a rebate of \$150. Widow or widowers over the age of 50 meeting the same income qualifications may also apply for the same rebate. Permanently disabled persons may obtain a refund of the \$200 fee. He moved that the ordinance be approved on its first reading and advertised. Seconded by Mr. Wechsler and carried.
