

TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD

ORDINANCE NO. 1534

AN ORDINANCE of the Township of Springfield, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, to further amend, supplement, change and modify the provisions of Ordinance No. 824, known as the "Code of the Township of Springfield," enacted and ordained January 14, 1969, as heretofore amended by amending Chapter 54, entitled "Garbage and Rubbish".

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Springfield, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That Chapter 54, Article I, Section 54-5 entitled "Fees", Paragraph A, subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3) thereof only, shall be amended to be and read as follows:

A. The fees for the collection and disposal of ashes, garbage and refuse shall be as follows:

- (1) The sum of \$215 per calendar year per residence building containing one (1) dwelling unit.
- (2) The owner of record of any residence building containing more than one (1) dwelling unit shall be charged the sum of \$215 per calendar year for each dwelling unit contained in said residence building for the collection of refuse from that residence building by the Township of Springfield.
- (3) The owner of a residential building or tenant obligated by the lease agreement to pay the refuse collection charge is eligible for a refuse fee rebate of up to \$150 provided the following conditions are met:
 - (a) Applicants must qualify under the Pennsylvania Property Tax or Rent Rebate Program (PA-1000).
 - (b) Applicants must present proof of payment indicating the amount received from the PA-1000 program.
 - (c) The Township refuse fee rebate will be equal to 25% of the amount of the State rebate check but will not exceed \$150.00.

ORDINANCE NO. 1535

AN ORDINANCE of the Township of Springfield, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, to further amend, supplement, change and modify the provisions of Ordinance No. 824, known as the "Code of the Township of Springfield," enacted and ordained January 14, 1969, as heretofore amended, by amending Chapter 109, entitled "Sewer Assessments".

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Springfield, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That Chapter 109, "Sewer Assessments", Section 109.12 entitled "Sewer Rental", Paragraph I, subsections (1) and (2) shall be amended to read as follows:

I. Amount of annual rental or charge; request for refund.

- (1) That for the year 2013, and annually thereafter, unless otherwise determined, the owner of any property located in the Township of Springfield, and/or served by the sewer system of the Township, shall pay to the township of Springfield an annual rental, or charge, for the use of the said sewer or sewer system equal to \$5.25 per 1,000 gallons of water consumed. ~~Said amount being determined and declared necessary to produce revenue sufficient to meet the requirements hereinbefore set forth.~~ Notwithstanding, the provisions of the chapter as to billing for sewer rentals, all property owners connected to the sewer system in the Township shall pay a minimum rental of \$25.00 per year.
- (2) The owner of a residential building or tenant obligated by the lease agreement to pay the sewer assessment is eligible for a sewer assessment rebate of \$25 provided the following conditions are met:
 - a. Applicants must qualify under the Pennsylvania Property Tax or Rent Rebate Program (PA-1000).
 - b. Applicants must present proof of payment indicating the amount received from the PA-1000 Program.
